## Treasurers Report 2024/5 for Huntley School PTFA. (Charity No. 284015).

Firstly as I always say at the start, I am very proud with the work and enthusiasm everyone has put in to raise important funds for Huntley School as well as bringing pleasure and help to the children and school community.

I would like to thank our donator who donated £2970 this year, it is very much appreciated. This is the final donation being made as child connected to donator has left Huntley School. Thanks also to The Red Lion for their donation of £500 and also Mayhill for donating £250 when the children sang at the Christmas event.

This year, Founders Day was held and made a wonderful profit of just under £2300. A great time was had by children and parents alike. During the year we also arranged Bags2Schools collections to help clear parents wardrobes, we also sold specially designed Tea Towels by the children. Raffles were held at the Christmas plays as well as the PTFA providing refreshments at them. We also held a Movie Day at the school which has become a popular event. Many thanks and congratulations to the PTFA's own Sian who conquered Snowdon and raised a massive £3112 in the process which was huge for the Intervention area project

The school Lottery was a big contributor as it has been since it began and added a good amount to funds, in 2025/25 it raised just over £1000. Money raised on this has dropped more recently so a push on this will help boost funds raised.

With increasing challenges on schools budgets, the PTFA aims to assist the school with not just the nice to have things, but also essentials. 2024/25 saw a number of projects funded totalling over £10,500! The PTFA funds purchased too many things to list, but included Bibs, Books, Trip subsidies which reduce parents costs, Gazebos, Microphones, a Projector, Chess sets, Music tuition for all, Visualizers and of course the Intervention area. It has potentially been the biggest year regards support to school that I have seen during my approx 8yrs with the PTFA and we want to continue benefitting the school next year.

2024/25 began with a balance of £18,799.67 in the PTFA Bank account and concluded with £20,141.73 PLEASE NOTE – within the PTFA Bank account is held a private donation of £6,284.66 for the school to use accordingly.

Finally, I would also like to give a huge thank you to all new and existing PTFA members for the work they have all put in to achieve such a great year, you are all brilliant.
