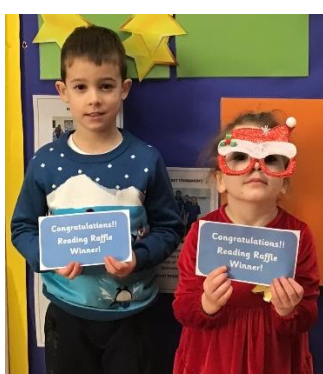
Congratulations to those children who gained 100% attendance awards this term.
