English: This term we will be reading a range of traditional tales from different European countries. We will study Hansel and Gretel and Baba Yaga. We will then write our own version of Baba Yaga. We will learn about instruction and recipe writing and test out our recipes!

RSHE: We will start our My Happy Mind journeys, beginning with recognising and understanding our emotions.

Mathematics:

Year 2

Understanding the place value of 2-digit numbers. Counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10.

Year 3

Understanding the place value of 3-digit numbers. Counting in steps of 3, 4, 8, 50 and 100.

Homework: Maths and spelling homework will be sent home on Fridays and will be due back the following **Wednesday**. **Make sure to practise your spellings every day at home!**
